Why Sea Breathe?

Our philosophy is “why carry scuba tanks if you don’t have to?” Traditionally divers have had to carry enough oxygen for their whole dive on their backs, at a weight of up to 20kg per 45 minutes. Not only is this heavy but it’s a barrier to working or having fun under water. The Sea Breathe solution is both simple and sophisticated. Our innovative electric snorkels pump air down from the surface, running on rechargeable batteries, backed by double-protection safety features to ensure a steady flow.

Sea Breathe’s DAMS Deck Models can operate either on the deck of your yacht, drawing power from its battery, or can be placed on a dock or dingy with an auxiliary battery. Deck Models are available for one or two divers. There is also a Float (buoy) version (see models 1300-FAMS and 2300-FAMS).

Who uses it?

Sea Breathe has already built up a strong following from a loyal customer base in Canada and the USA. Commercial divers choose Sea Breathe because of the flexibility it offers. Shipyards and yacht owners choose Sea Breathe to avoid the cost of dry-docking for minor repairs and maintenance, while pool designers have come to appreciate the advantages of being able to correct defects below the surface without draining down. Sea Breathe is designed for maximum safety and durability. It uses only the highest grade components.

- 12 volt battery operation with 12 foot cable and clips for attachment
- 30 foot flexible hoses with quick release couplings
- High- and low-pressure relief valves to save energy
- Dual air filtration with reliable diaphragm pump construction
- Folding air reservoir for added safety
- Anodized to prevent corrosion, with all stainless steel valves
- Virtually maintenance free, with a spares pack as standard
- Tough polyethylene case and quick-dry hose carrying bag
